Rules and criteria governing this award

1. Students must be of Dominican descent. They must be pursuing or plan to pursue post-secondary education during the academic year when the application is submitted or plan to enroll following submission of application in a post-secondary school.
2. The selection of award recipients will be based on the following criteria:
 - a) The student's academic record, minimum GPA of 3.0/4.0 or 4.0/5.0.
 - b) The student's participation in school, college and/or outside jobs/ activities as outlined in the student's essay and in the letters of recommendation from school counselors and/or teachers/professors.
 - c) The student's reason(s) for pursuing post-secondary education, as outlined in the student's career essay.
 - d) The strength of the student's personal statement outlining his/her post-secondary objectives and community/school services as well as financial needs.
 - e) Commitment to serving as a volunteer at two DAMA-sponsored events during the year following receipt of the award.
3. DAMA will grant only one (Individual) award for the full academic year in the amount of at least \$1,000. The winner will be announced and given the award at the DAMA's Annual Gala event, and recipient must be present to receive it. Payment will be disbursed to the student upon receipt of a copy of the proof of current spring-semester school registration.

1. From the **student**:
 - a) A completed application form (this form)
 - b) A personal statement of no more than 300 words that must include information about the applicant's post secondary objectives and community/school service activities outlining the following:
 - * Community/school or volunteer service activities
 - * Your proposed field of study and future career plans
 - * Your academic strengths and challenges
 - c) An official high school or college transcript.
2. Two letters of recommendation from teachers or professors, counselors, and/or school officials containing, but not limited to the following:
 - a) Verification of student's GPA, and graduation date from HS.
 - b) Information about the student's strengths, leadership skills and
